Brown County Homeless and Housing Coalition Membership Level Requirements

1. Partner Organization Member

Any public or private corporation (both for profit and nonprofit), government jurisdiction, or education institution (school district, college, or university, both public and private) are eligible to join the coalition as a Partner Organization Member. Such organizations support the mission of Coalition and wish to actively participate in Coalition meetings, committees or activities.

Requirements for the Partner Organization Membership:

- a. Act as good stewards of the Coalition.
- b. Provide requested data for Coalition-sponsored activities that document the services provided by the Partner Organization. Disclosure of confidential information will not be required.
- c. Payment of membership dues.

2. Advocate Individual Member

Individuals that support the mission of the Coalition and wish to actively participate in Coalition meetings, committees or activities. The Executive Committee may waive or modify these requirements for persons who are homeless, at risk of becoming homeless or with limited income.

Requirements for the Advocate Individual Membership:

- a. Act as good stewards of the Coalition.
- b. Payment of membership dues.

Membership dues may be adjusted or waived if extraordinary circumstances prevent an organization or individual from making payment. If seeking membership dues adjustment or waiver, please submit a written request to the Membership Committee for review.

Brown County Homeless and Housing Coalition Membership Level Benefits

Benefits of Partner Organization Membership:

- a. Organization is listed in Coalition media as a “Partner Organization.”
- b. Participation in Coalition collaborative grant activities.
- c. Eligible to request goods and funding received on behalf of the Coalition.
- d. Receive Coalition meeting minutes and communications.
- e. Eligible to vote as stated in the Bylaws, 1 vote per agency.

Benefits of Advocate Individual Membership:

- a. Individual is listed in Coalition media as an “Advocate Individual Member”.
- b. Receive Coalition meeting minutes and communications.
- c. Eligible to vote as stated in the Bylaws, 1 vote per individual.
